



MODEL APPLICANT FACTS

- Girls assigned to size 10 will model American Girl Historical and Contemporary clothing. Those assigned to size 6x will model American Girl's Little Girl clothing. The American Girl size chart is included for your reference. **If you are unsure if your child fits within the measurements listed, please contact argyle@mcfta.org for additional clarification.**
- American Girl dolls are diverse; we encourage girls of all races and cultures to apply.
- To be accepted, application **must be complete** including parental consent, size measurements, and current photograph (preferably full length shot). Please write the child and parent's name on the back of the picture. Photographs will not be returned.
- Selected models will be assigned to at least one of three show groups – Saturday, October 26th (12pm or 4pm) or Sunday, October 27th (2pm). Attempts are made to assign girls to historical outfits based upon their likeness to a particular doll. **Show preferences will be considered in the order the applications are received.**
- Models must be available for an orientation and a dress rehearsal based upon the schedule listed on the application form.
- Rehearsals will take approximately two hours and include a run through of the full show as well as individual group practice times.
- Performances will take approximately three hours including pre-performance arrival and refreshments with family following the show.
- Models must be able to be away from parents for three hours (one hour before the show and two hours during the performance) and feel comfortable walking a runway in front of 300 people.
- Parents are required to sign their daughters in and out of each show activity. MCFTA staff and volunteers will lead rehearsal activities and assist with preparation including day-of-show dressing.
- Models may be required to supply footwear depending on the costume. Typical examples include black dress shoes, ballet slippers, or tennis shoes.

OTHER DETAILS

- Parents are required to purchase tickets to see the show, including the show in which their daughter appears.
- Each Show includes:
 - ~ An assigned seat for the American Girl Fashion Show®
 - ~ Elegant refreshments in the cafe following each show
 - ~ A special party favor bag **for children attending & modeling in the show only**
 - ~ A chance to win special door prizes drawn randomly at each show
 - ~ Unique raffle packages at each show with raffle tickets purchased prior to start of the show
 - ~ Entrance to the special American Girl Fashion Show® Marketplace including the book store, souvenir shop, and doll hair salon
- Photography is not allowed during the show; however, arrangements will be made to have professional photographs taken and available for sale. Photography will be allowed during the dress rehearsal.
